Iceland is a Nordic island nation that is defined by its dramatic landscape of volcanoes, geysers, hot springs, and lava fields. Though Reykjavik has its own draws, the area surrounding it boasts an incredible wealth of scenery and activities. While it isn't quite the whole country in microcosm, it comes close. Just a couple of hours outside of the city, you'll suddenly find yourself walking on lava rocks, with one foot on the European continent and the other on the North American continent. Experience the mist of a spectacular waterfall on your face and watch a geyser blow. The land feels strangely unformed, caught in geological transition. The beauty is pure, raw, otherworldly and exciting!

Noted for its vast tundra and immense glaciers, Greenland lies between the North Atlantic and Arctic oceans and is considered the biggest island in the world. An autonomous Danish territory, Greenland sits on the North American continent but is geographically part of Europe. Two-thirds of the island extends above the Arctic Circle and most of its landscape is covered by a massive ice cap, second only to Antarctica's in size.

Long, deep fjords reach far into both the east and west coasts of Greenland in complex systems, offering magnificent, desolate scenery. Along many parts of the coast, the ice sheet sits on the edge of the coastline and large chunks of glacier will calve and slide into the water and emerge as icebergs.

Golden Circle Tour (1- and 6-Night Packages)

After enjoying your final breakfast on board the ship, you will disembark the ship and board your coach for your next adventure to discover the natural wonders that lie just outside of Reykjavik. The Golden Circle is one of the most famous tours in Iceland and includes visits to Thingvellir National Park, Geysir Hot Springs and Gullfoss Waterfalls.

Your first stop today is Thingvellir National Park, the original site of the oldest existing parliament in the world, founded in the year 930. Thingvellir is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is situated on the Mid-Atlantic Ridge. Here, you will literally walk between the continents of Europe and North America. Situated in Thingvellir National Park is the impressive

Almannagja gorge. It is one of the park's most impressive and well known features and marks the eastern boundary of the North American Plate. After this, you'll be taken to a natural bakery, the Geothermal Bakery at Laugarvatn Lake. Here you will experience a geothermal bakery first hand and watch as a pot of fresh bread is dug out from the hot black sand, after baking for a full 24 hours. You'll get to taste this amazing Geysir Bread, piping hot, served hot from the ground with some butter...an Icelandic delicacy for sure!

After, enjoying a tasty piece of this famous bread, you'll be taken by your coach to the Geysir geothermal area, with its boiling mud pools and exploding geysers, the most famous of which are Geysir and Strokkur. Geysir no longer erupts but the lively Strokkur is a mighty geyser, erupting every 4-8 minutes and reaching on average 65 feet into the air, and sometimes as high as 131 feet.

You'll work up an appetite so your next stop is Geysir Hotel Restaurant, halfway between Geysir and Gullfoss Waterfall, for a wonderful Icelandic buffet style lunch.

Our last stop of the day is the powerful Gullfoss (Golden) Waterfall, on the popular rafting river, Hvítá (white) River, which is fed by Iceland's second biggest glacier, the Langjökull. Plummeting 104 feet into the river gorge, Gullfoss offers a spectacular view of the forces and beauty of untouched nature. This is Iceland's most famous waterfall and one of its most beautiful. You can even get close enough to feel the water spray on your face!

After taking in this beautiful waterfall, you'll board your coach for the drive back to Reykjavik. Upon arrival to the hotel you will check-in and make your way to your room where your luggage will be waiting for you. You are free to enjoy Reykjavik on your own this evening.



Flight to Ilulissat, Greenland & Guided Ilulissat City Walking Tour (6-Night Package Only)

Today after breakfast, you'll get ready for the next chapter in your great journey! You'll meet in the lobby to board your coach to the Keflavik Airport where you will board your plane for your 3+ hour flight to Ilulissat, Greenland.

Upon arrival in Ilulissat, you will be taken to the Hotel Ilulissat, right away for check-in. Ilulissat's newest 4-star accommodation, Hotel Ilulissat, is ideally situated in the heart of town and just a short walk from the Ilulissat Icefjord—a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the world's natural wonders.

After checking in you will meet your guide to go on your Ilulissat City Tour with your local guide! Ilulissat is a coastal town in western Greenland that is best known for the Ilulissat Icefjord and the huge icebergs in Disko Bay from the Sermeq Kujalleq glacier. It is the third largest city in Greenland and is home to almost as many sled-dogs as people!

Your guided city walking tour will give you an introduction to Ilulissat and the everyday life as well as the town's history and the culture along with Greenland's history in general. You'll visit the historic part of town, back to the start of the Danish trading station, and the fishermen at the harbor by their trading post "Brædtet". You'll also learn about administration and politics in modern Greenland. As well as a visit to the Knud Rasmussen museum, a museum dedicated to the famous Danish explorer Knud Rasmussen, where you will find an educational exhibit as well as a traditional Greenlandic turf house.

After getting acquainted with Ilulissat and learning about the history and culture of this beautiful city, you will be taken back to the hotel to freshen up before your dinner. A three-course dinner will be served at the hotel this evening.

After dinner, you'll get dressed in warm clothes for your evening sailing out to the famous Ilulissat Icefjord, considered the world's largest ice sculpture park. Your experience will be awe-inspiring as you take in the sounds and changing light and colors of the ice!

Sermermiut Valley, an Inuit Settlement inclusive of lunch (6-Night Package Only)

After enjoying breakfast at your hotel, you'll travel by van to the stunning Sermermiut Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This ancient Inuit settlement has been home to various Inuit cultures over the past 4,500 years, and remnants of their time here can still be found today.

Your visit begins at the Icefjord Centre, where you'll embark on an extraordinary journey into Greenlandic nature and culture. Through the permanent exhibition, "Sermeq pillugu Oqaluttuaq - The Story of the Ice", you'll learn about the life cycle of the ice, the diverse wildlife around the Icefjord, and the human presence in this region over millennia. In spring, summer, and autumn, you can enjoy one of Greenland's most breathtaking views from the Centre's rooftop, overlooking the Icefjord Kangia. The Centre also features art installations, a shop, and a café, where you can relax with a coffee or a light snack.

Following your time at the Icefjord Centre, your guide will lead you on a walking tour through the beautiful Sermermiut Valley, offering incredible views of the Icefjord and its towering icebergs. Along the way, you'll see the ruins of ancient Inuit dwellings while your guide shares insights into the different Inuit cultures that first settled here more than 4,500 years ago. At a scenic viewpoint overlooking Disko Bay and the Icefjord, you'll pause to enjoy a warm drink and cookies.

After the excursion, you'll return to the hotel for lunch. The afternoon is yours to explore Ilulissat, take a hike along the Icefjord, or join an optional excursion.

This evening, a delicious three-course dinner will be served at the hotel.

Upon arrival, our guide will lead you on a fascinating tour of the settlement, where you'll explore the school, church, and fish factory. Along the way, you'll hear captivating stories about life in this small community and learn about Oqaatsut's rich history as a former whaling village.

The tour concludes with a delightful lunch at Restaurant H8 Explorer, featuring dishes prepared with fresh, local ingredients. After lunch, you can choose to hike through the surrounding landscapes or simply relax and soak in the serene atmosphere of this magical setting.

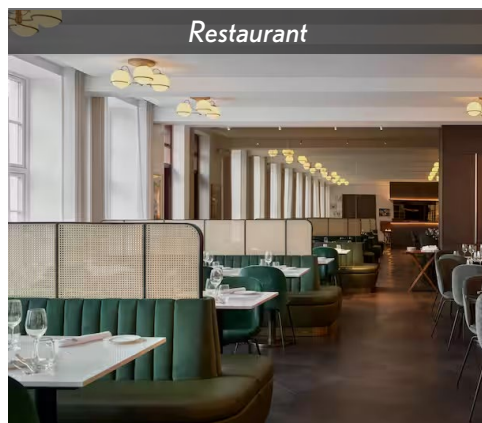
As the day winds down, we'll sail back to Ilulissat, leaving you with unforgettable memories of this extraordinary experience.

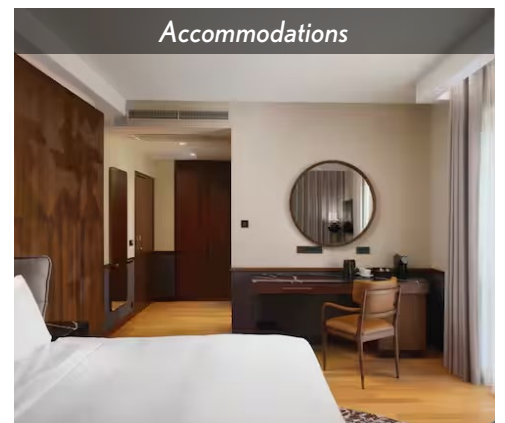

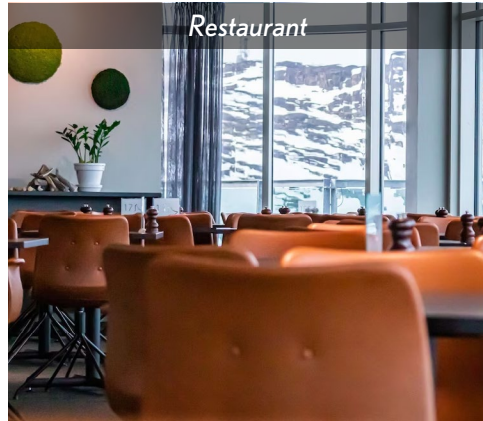

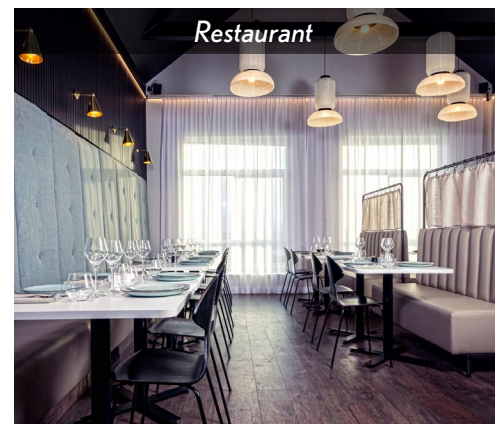
