In addition, the Old Town tour on embarkation day is a walking tour.

If you have limited mobility but would still like to participate fully, you are required to travel with someone who can assist you throughout the journey, as our team will not be able to provide individual mobility support. JULY 18 – ABBA & THE VASA MUSEUMS WITH LUNCH (3-night package)

After breakfast this morning, you'll set off for an exciting day exploring two of Stockholm's most iconic attractions—the Vasa Museum and the ABBA Museum, located just a five-minute walk from one another.

Your day begins at the Vasa Museum, home to the world's only fully preserved 17th-century warship. Dramatic, beautifully detailed, and remarkably intact, the Vasa is a true Swedish national treasure and an unforgettable glimpse into the country's maritime history.

Next, it's time to turn up the volume at the ABBA Museum—a lively, interactive celebration of Sweden's most legendary pop group. From costumes and memorabilia to immersive exhibits that let you sing, dance, and step into the ABBA story yourself, this visit is equal parts music, nostalgia, and pure fun.

After enjoying both museums, we'll head to lunch at the charming and historic Villa Godthem, a late-19th-century Swiss-style merchant's villa turned classic Stockholm restaurant. Here, you'll enjoy a three-course traditional Swedish lunch in one of the city's most beloved settings. Following lunch, the tour returns to the hotel, and you'll have the afternoon free to continue exploring Stockholm at your leisure.



JULY 19 – STOCKHOLM ARCHIPELAGO CRUISE WITH SWEDISH BBQ LUNCH AND MIDSUMMER GAMES

(3-night package)

Today, step back in time as we board a classic turn-of-the-century ship, designed to transport you more than 100 years into the past with its beautiful period décor and nostalgic ambience. The captain and crew will be waiting at the gangplank to welcome you aboard, setting the tone for a truly memorable day on the water.

Once everyone is settled, we'll sail out of Stockholm's harbor, offering spectacular views of the city from the sea—a truly stunning perspective of Stockholm's islands, waterfront, and elegant architecture. There is an onboard café with drinks and snacks available for purchase, perfect for enjoying the breeze as we cruise.

We'll continue into the breathtaking Stockholm Archipelago, making our way toward the charming island town of Vaxholm. Here you'll catch views of the impressive Vaxholm Fortress, originally built in the 1500s as a defensive stronghold, rich with Swedish history. Just beyond Vaxholm lies the small island of Badholmen. An island that is only 500 meters across and privately reserved exclusively for our group. This hidden gem offers the perfect setting for an unforgettable afternoon.

On arrival, you'll be greeted at a traditional red Swedish house, used for private gatherings, and welcomed with a welcome drink on the porch. Then, the fun begins! Guests are invited to enjoy classic Swedish lawn games on the grassy grounds while the cooks fire up the grill and prepare our feast. A delicious traditional Swedish BBQ buffet will be served, inside the charming house. Weather permitting, you're also welcome to relax outdoors on the deck, take in the fresh sea air, and listen to the gentle waves along the shore.

And no Swedish summer celebration would be complete without a true highlight: a festive Midsummer dance around the maypole, giving you the chance to experience a joyful mini version of Sweden's most beloved holiday tradition.

After a day filled with scenery, culture, food, and celebration, we'll return to the ship for a beautiful cruise back to Stockholm.

JULY 20 – STEP BACK IN TIME: DISCOVER THE SECRETS OF STOCKHOLM'S OLD TOWN WALKING TOUR

WITH TRANSFER TO SHIP (3- and 1-night packages)

After breakfast, we'll step into the storybook charm of Gamla Stan, Stockholm's enchanting Old Town, for a guided walking tour through one of the best-preserved medieval city centers in Europe.

Our journey begins in Stortorget Square, the historic heart of Stockholm, where colorful merchant buildings surround you and history feels alive. Here, you'll hear the dramatic tale of the Stockholm Bloodbath of 1520—one of Sweden's most pivotal and unforgettable historical moments.


From there, we'll wander through a maze of cobblestoned streets and narrow medieval alleyways, taking in centuries-old architecture, charming storefronts, Gothic churches, and hidden corners that most visitors never find. Along the way, your guide will share captivating stories of Stockholm's past from trade and wartime remnants to the legendary figures immortalized throughout the city in statues and landmarks.

The tour also includes time along the lively main shopping street. We'll wrap up in true Swedish style with a cozy café stop for a traditional Fika—enjoy coffee (or tea) and a freshly baked cinnamon roll, just like the locals. Following our Old Town exploration, we'll visit the magnificent Royal Palace, where you'll enjoy a guided tour through the grand state rooms and view the sparkling Crown Jewels – an unforgettable glimpse into Sweden's royal history and tradition.

Following your visit to the Royal Palace, coaches will meet you for the transfer to the ship. Enjoy a final farewell to Stockholm as you prepare to embark on the incredible cruise ahead.
