Known for Guinness, whiskey, and some of the greenest countryside in the world, Dublin is the capital of the Republic of Ireland. It was voted Europe's fourth most popular city and destination behind London, Paris, and Rome, and is one of the friendliest cities in the world. It is also one of Europe's most beautiful cities, with its elegant Georgian Architecture and medieval buildings, including the 13th-century Dublin Castle, the imposing St. Patrick's Cathedral, and Temple Bar. Not to be left out is Grafton Street, the bustling, largely pedestrian-only shopping area famed for its buskers.

Dublin's history takes us back to when it was founded as a Viking settlement, known as the Kingdom of Dublin. It became Ireland's principal city following the Norman invasion. Today, Dublin is still a principal city and is famous for its laid-back charm and cultural heritage. It is the capital of The Craic (pronounced 'crack'), the art of life. With its famous writers, such as Oscar Wilde, James Joyce, and playwright Samuel Beckett, and, of course, the band U2, The Craic have helped shape Dublin into what it is now: a vibrant capital that moves at an easygoing pace.

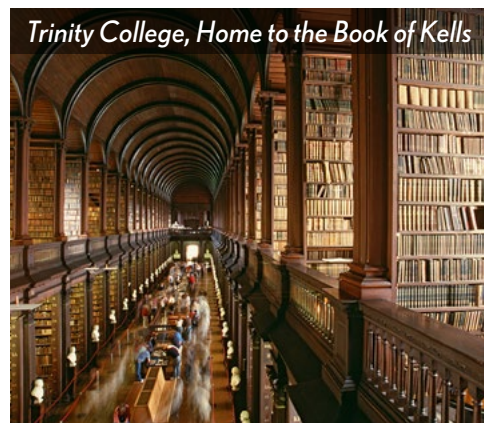
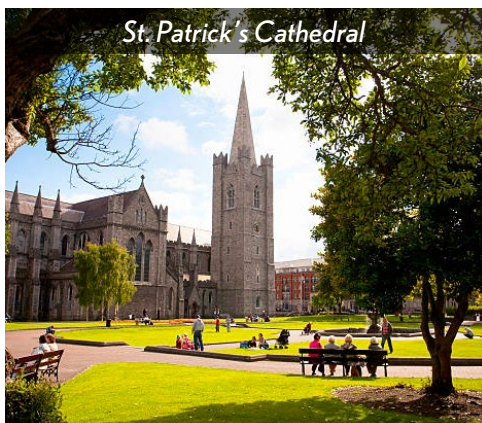

JUNE 15 & JUNE 17 – DUBLIN CITY TOUR, INCLUDING LUNCH AND GROUP DINNER IN AN AUTHENTIC IRISH PUB

This morning after breakfast, you'll set off for a day exploring this charming European capital city.

Our day begins with a visit to the impressive St. Patrick's Cathedral, Ireland's largest church, with a history spanning more than 800 years. Enjoy a guided tour of its stunning, ornate interior while learning about the legacy of Ireland's oldest Christian site.

From there, we'll make our way through central Dublin to the Guinness Storehouse for an immersive tour that reveals the ingredients and craftsmanship behind Ireland's most iconic pint. A complimentary glass of Guinness is included for all participants.

With our appetites stirred, we'll pause for lunch at Café En Seine—an art nouveau gem known for its elegant indoor garden and charming atmosphere.

This afternoon, we'll stroll through Trinity College to its renowned library for an unforgettable visit to the Book of Kells. As part of the Olivia group, you'll skip the lines and step straight into this remarkable exhibit. Created in the ninth century, the Book of Kells contains the four Gospels and is considered Ireland's greatest cultural treasure. Your visit also includes access to the Long Room, one of the world's most beautiful libraries, home to 200,000 of Trinity College's oldest volumes.

Our tour concludes back at your hotel, where you'll have some time to unwind before tonight's festivities.

This evening, join your fellow Olivians for an authentic Irish dinner, complete with traditional music and dance at the Merry Ploughboy Pub. The evening begins with a lively performance by The Merry Ploughboys, Dublin's premier traditional Irish music group, entertaining audiences since 1989 and hosting Ireland's longest-running show with the same performers for over 26 years. Midway through, world champion Irish dancers from Dublin and beyond will take the stage. A night filled with genuine Irish music, dance, and warm hospitality is guaranteed.

JUNE 16 – DUBLIN COASTLINE TOUR VISITING MALAHIDE CASTLE AND HOWTH HEAD (3-night package)

Today, we'll travel just outside of Dublin to explore Malahide Castle and the scenic coastal area of Howth Head. Malahide Castle, set on 250 acres of lush parkland in the charming seaside town of Malahide, served as both a fortress and a family home for nearly 800 years. Its architecture reflects centuries of history, shaped by generations of the Talbot family, who lived here from 1185 until 1973, when the last Lord Talbot passed away.

Inside, the castle is filled with elegant period furnishings and an impressive collection of Irish portrait paintings, most on loan from the National Gallery. The Great Hall tells the story of the Talbot family through portraits spanning generations, offering a window into Ireland's turbulent past.

One of the most poignant stories is from the morning of the Battle of the Boyne in 1690, when fourteen members of the family shared breakfast in the hall—none of whom returned, as all were killed by nightfall.

Though the castle has undergone additions and changes over the centuries, the surrounding parklands have remained largely untouched, preserving their historic charm. You'll have time to explore the beautifully maintained gardens and wander the grounds of this romantic estate, rich with legend and history.

We'll then board our coaches and continue to Howth Head, a picturesque fishing village known for its steep winding streets, striking coastal views, and notable landmarks such as the Martello Tower and the atmospheric ruins of Howth Abbey. Here we will enjoy lunch at the Abbey Tavern and after we will have some free time to explore this quaint and bustling fishing town.

After your free time, we'll journey back through the scenic countryside for one final evening on your own in Dublin. Enjoy the night as you wish before the next chapter of your adventure.

JUNE 17 – WONDERFUL WICKLOW TOUR VISITING GLENDALOUGH, POWERSCOURT ESTATE AND THE COUNTRYSIDE (3-night package)

After breakfast, we'll depart for County Wicklow, traveling through some of Ireland's most breathtaking scenery—serene lakes, dramatic glacial valleys, and rugged mountain peaks.

Our first stop is Glendalough, the “valley of two lakes,” a stunning glacial valley best known for its Early Medieval monastic settlement founded in the 6th century. Established by St. Kevin, Glendalough became one of the most important religious centers in Europe.

The remains of this ancient Monastic City are scattered throughout the glen and include a remarkable round tower, several medieval stone churches, and intricately carved crosses. One highlight is St. Kevin's Bed—a small man-made cave above the Upper Lake. Legend says St. Kevin lived and prayed there, though it may actually be a prehistoric burial site predating him by centuries.

You'll learn about the history and significance of this sacred place at the interpretive center before exploring the grounds, where sweeping views of the lakes and the deeply peaceful atmosphere make this site truly unforgettable.

After our time in Glendalough, we'll continue to Powerscourt Estate, an elegant 18th-century mansion surrounded by 47 acres of Italian, Japanese, and statuary gardens. Enjoy a self-guided tour of the formal gardens, then take time for lunch on your own at the Powerscourt Restaurant terrace, overlooking the estate's expansive grounds and the mountains beyond. Following your visit to Powerscourt, we'll reboard our coaches for the ship, bidding farewell to Dublin as you prepare for the incredible cruise ahead.
