Situated on Scotland's east coast, Edinburgh is the capital city of Scotland and a world class destination. Enriched with culture and Georgian architecture, it is home to the Scottish Parliament. We will visit the national symbol of Scotland, Edinburgh Castle, which rests on an extinct volcano, as well as the Royal Yacht Britannia, once home to Her Majesty, The Queen, and the Royal Family. A modern-day Jekyll and Hyde, the city is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, split between the medieval Old Town and the Georgian magnificence of the New Town.

Many wonders and much splendor await us in the Scottish countryside. Discover Stirling, the former capital of Scotland and home to Stirling Castle, once the residence of Mary, Queen of Scots. And of course, no visit to Scotland would be complete without learning about and tasting the Scotch whisky at Scotland's oldest working distillery.



## JUNE 25, 2026 – EDINBURGH CITY TOUR, INCLUDING THE ROYAL YACHT BRITANNIA & EDINBURGH CASTLE

### WITH LUNCH AT THE BERTIES PROPER FISH & CHIPS (1- & 2-night packages)

This morning, you'll bid farewell to the *Star Pride* and board your coach for a full day of exploring Edinburgh, beginning with the Royal Yacht Britannia, followed by a panoramic city tour and a visit to Edinburgh Castle.

Your first stop is the Royal Yacht Britannia, the former floating home of the British Monarchy, which served Queen Elizabeth II and the Royal Family for over 40 years. During her service from 1954 to 1997, she sailed more than 1,000,000 miles to over 600 ports in 135 countries. Now berthed in Leith, the yacht offers a unique opportunity to follow in the footsteps of royalty and discover the inner workings of this remarkable vessel.



Next, venture into New Town, Edinburgh's neoclassical gem. Developed in the 18<sup>th</sup> century, its broad streets showcase striking Georgian architecture, offering a window into the city's sophisticated past. Explore George Street, lined with designer shops, trendy bars, and elegant restaurants, and wander Dundas Street, home to galleries, antique shops, and independent boutiques—a perfect mix of culture and charm.

Before heading to Old Town, you'll stop for a delicious lunch at Bertie's Proper Fish & Chips, a local favorite that captures the heart of Scottish cuisine.

After lunch, board your coaches to explore Old Town, a labyrinth of cobbled streets, narrow alleyways, and hidden courtyards, steeped in history. At the heart of Old Town is the Royal Mile, stretching from the Palace of Holyrood House up to the majestic Edinburgh Castle. Perched atop an extinct volcano, Edinburgh Castle is a striking symbol of Scotland and a key part of the city's World Heritage Site. Highlights include the Honors of Scotland (Crown Jewels), the Stone of Destiny, the 15<sup>th</sup>-century gun Mons Meg, the One O'Clock Gun, and the National War Museum of Scotland.

After exploring Old Town and the castle, you'll board the coach for your hotel for check-in. Dinner tonight is on your own, giving you the freedom to enjoy Edinburgh at your leisure.

## JUNE 26, 2026 – STIRLING CASTLE, GLENTURRET DISTILLERY WITH LUNCH AT THE BIRDS AND THE BEES

### (2-night package)

After breakfast, leave the city behind and venture into the stunning Scottish countryside for a visit to Glenturret Distillery and Stirling Castle.

Make sure you eat a hearty breakfast as our first stop this morning is the Glenturret Distillery, Scotland's oldest working distillery, where tradition and heritage come alive. Learn the centuries-old craft of single malt whisky-making, explore the distillery's colorful history, and of course, enjoy a tasting of their exquisite whisky.

Next, enjoy lunch at The Birds and The Bees Pub, a charming eatery set in a converted farm steading, just a stone's throw from both Stirling Castle and the historic Wallace Monument. Savor award-winning dishes made from locally sourced seasonal ingredients, accompanied by real ales and an extensive wine list.

After lunch, continue your journey to Stirling Castle. Perched majestically atop a volcanic crag, Stirling Castle is one of Scotland's grandest and most iconic fortresses. Its commanding position and impressive architecture make it a powerful symbol of Scottish independence and national pride. The castle's turbulent history is intertwined with legendary figures such as William Wallace and Mary, Queen of Scots, and it has withstood at least eight sieges, including several during the Wars of Scottish Independence. The last attempt to capture it was in 1746, when Bonnie Prince Charlie famously failed to take the fortress.

After your visiting Stirling Castle, board your coach for the return to Edinburgh, where your evening is free to relax and enjoy dinner at your leisure.
